

Lesson Plan

Grade level(s): 9-12

Topic: LILI-D Navigation

Objective(s): Teach students how to navigate a data bases and how a data base differs from a web search engine.

Big6 Skills: Information Seeking Strategies

Materials Required: Computer Lab

Time Required: 20 Minutes

Description of activities:

- 1) Have Students sit at tables
- 2) Librarian gives very short lecture ion how data bases and web search engines differ
- 3) Have students go through a guided series of searches in LILI-D
- 4) Have students search in LILI-D on their own, looking for information on the assigned classroom topic.
- 5) As students search they need to take a minimum of 4 screen shots of the information that they find.
 - the screen shots will allow them to provide proof of their searches
 - the screen shots are necessary because permanent link will not function within the data base
 - Screen shots will be emailed to the classroom teacher

Assessment: The screen shots emailed to the teacher will allow the teacher to have an exit slip that will help to keep the class on task and working. The screen shots will also let the teacher and librarian together see what areas of LILI-D are being used and what trouble the students are having so that in a later review activity those issues can be targeted.
